Highlight: The Committee's priority lies in addressing for issues such as efficiency, safety, environmental consciousness and sustainable transport solutions. In 2012, the Committee engaged successfully with the Singapore government and its agencies, having secured a meeting with the Ministry of Transport (MOT), Land Transport Authority (LTA) and National Environment Agency (NEA). The next Committee meeting will be dedicated to pursuing the advocacy initiative by following up with the government's progress and planning the next meeting with them.

The aim of the study/position paper would be for Europe to be acknowledged as a benchmark for Sustainable architecture, building infrastructure engineering.

Highlight: At the next ICT Committee meeting, members will be updated on current topics of interest regarding to ICT in Singapore and the region. The members will focus on activities for 2012 which will include the final need for suggested ICT activities in Singapore, provision of secondment payments, the SUSTA ICT charter and terms spectrum issues, digital dividend and the encouragement of ICT skills and competencies (e.g. with Learning Centres of Excellence).
